Ambassador of Ukraine to the Republic of Korea



Born on 20 January 1962 in Donetsk (Ukraine)

Vasyl Marmazov received his Ph.D. in Law from Taras Shevchenko National University of Kyiv (Ukraine's top law school), and previously holds Law Degree from the above mentioned University. He also improved his academic skills at London School of Economics (UK), Sidney Sussex College (Cambridge, UK), International Institute of Human Rights (Strasbourg, France) and Stanford University (USA).

His previous work experience includes acting as the deputy dean of the Faculty of Law of Taras Shevchenko National University of Kyiv, practicing law as the Lawyer at the European Court of Human Rights (Strasbourg, France) and a Partner of Yuris Law Offices (a prominent and highly acclaimed law firm in Ukraine), and serving as the deputy ministers in Ministry of Justice, Ministry of Internal Affairs and Ministry of Economy of Ukraine. Throughout his tenure as a professor and in his various government positions, Marmazov has concentrated his efforts on democratic reform in Ukraine and transposing fundamental human rights principles in Ukrainian legal system.
